

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. This show is affiliated to the NPS and will be judged under the rules of the National Pony Society. Please refer to the 2008 Rule Book for further guidance
2. All foals must be weaned.
3. All foals must be aged 20 weeks or over.
4. No foal may be shown in a bit of any type.
5. Foals must only be shown in a halter or head collar.
6. No foal/yearling to be lunged.
7. No foal is to be clipped out.
8. Mountain & Moorland foals to be eligible for entry in their respective stud books.
9. All persons attending this show do so at their own risk. The Committee does not accept responsibility for any accidents to persons, their animals or property. Entries accepted and admission granted subject to these conditions.
10. We strongly recommend that all exhibitors carry Public Liability Insurance.
11. The organisers reserve the right to decline any entry without assigning a reason.
12. The decision of the Judges and Organisers is FINAL.
13. Any objection must be handed to the Secretary in writing within 10 minutes of the alleged incident accompanied by a £10 deposit returnable if the objection is upheld.
14. No pony to be plaited in Mountain and Moorland classes.
15. The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate or divide classes where entries permit.
16. In the event of cancellation, a proportion of the entry fee may be withheld to cover administration costs.

Additional Ridden Rules

17. Correctly secured current British Standard Skull Caps / Riding Hats must be worn at all times when mounted on the showground.
18. Stallions – riders of M & M small breed or ponies not exceeding 138cm must have attained their 11th birthday and riders of large breeds or those 138cm or over must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year.
19. No spurs to be worn.
20. Snaffle bridle, with cavesson noseband only allowed in the class. No other tack except a correctly fitted standing martingale to be used for warming up.
21. No ponies on the leading rein.
22. No riders under the age of 5 years on the day of the show.

The highest placed Wessex Area Subscriber in each In Hand class, 1st – 3rd place will receive a special rosette, providing a white armband is worn when entering the class. Those winning a rosette will be eligible for their respective Members Foal or Yearling Championship.
